Resident Member (30-35)	\$1,764 - \$2,942	\$1,650
Incremental annual increases in yearly fees over five years until members reach the age of 36.		
GTA Resident Member	\$1,725	\$2,000
Residence or <u>business</u> within the Greater Toronto Area (Halton, Peel, York and Durham) and does not reside or carry on business within the City of Toronto.		
Non-Resident Member	\$979	\$1140
Residence and <u>business</u> outside the City of Toronto and GTA.		
Junior Member (18-29)	\$1,588	\$1050
Student	\$410	\$310
An individual who has attained the age of eighteen and is attending a University, Law School or other post secondary institution on a full-time basis. Letter of enrollment required.		
Political Member	\$698	No entrance fee

Open to any elected conservative member of a municipal council, provincial or territorial legislature or the House of Commons of Canada, any conservative appointee to the Senate of Canada, any full-time member of the political staff of any such elected member or appointee and any full-time employee of a conservative political party or affiliate organization thereof may be nominated for admission as a Member in the Political Category by the board of directors of the Club, regardless of his or her place of residence or business. Where there is no official conservative party or equivalent, the board may deem such a party to be in existence or recognize an existing party, regardless of name, in each instance, on a case by case basis. Upon ceasing to be qualified for the Political category, the member shall become that category of Member as described in Section 6(1), according to the circumstances at that time, without payment of any entrance fee and with such annual fees as are applicable to the appropriate Membership category at the time, such fees to be assessed on the next billing date following such Member's departure from the Political category. A one time **\$350 capital assessment** fee will apply upon acceptance and activation of membership

*Annual dues do not include a \$25 monthly special dues assessment for 3 years from activation date.
